## Your Gift

Choosing to make a gift beyond your lifetime through a Bequest is a simple and effective way of paying tribute to the values of the College.

## Types of Bequests

There are three major types of bequests:

### Specific Bequests:

These are defined personal assets such as books, shares, cars and other items given to a particular organisation.

### General Bequests:

Usually sums of money or a percentage of an estate.

### Residual Bequests:

The remainder of your estate after specific bequests, debts, taxes and other expenses have been paid.

A bequest does not need to be a large sum of money. In fact, every gift makes a difference. Ask your solicitor how you can include a bequest in your will.
